The design idea came from a JavaScript code of a cloth. I thought that the folding and stretching of a cloth is similar to the appearance and disappearance of human existence in this interconnected and interdependent universe.

I wanted to express the nature of emptiness in Buddhism. Emptiness in Buddhism means that everything changes endlessly. It does not mean hollowness. But I did not use the word "emptiness" in the description on my website because it might be misinterpreted.

I used rectangular picture frames because we recognize things as separate when we perceive them inside a confined frame. However, the reality is that we are all connected and interdependent.
